

2021 IICB Certified Rigger and Signalperson Report

Certification Process completed with NCCA in April 2021.

Proctor and Observer Training in 2021

During 2021, eighteen (18) Ironworkers passed the written and practical exam then took the Proctor and Observer Training.

2021 Exam Performance

Throughout 2021 the **Computer Based** exam was given to a total of 127 examinees.

69 passed the first attempt or 54%

11 passed the second attempt or .09%

47 failed both attempts or 37%

Performance Evaluation

80 Candidates were eligible to take the five-section performance evaluation.

27 Candidates or 34% passed the performance exam on their first attempt.

10 Candidates or 13% passed the performance exam on their second attempt.

4 or .05% failed the performance exam on both attempts. See Candidate manual for more information.

16 Candidates did not attempt the performance exam on the second attempt.

23 Candidates did not attempt the performance exam.

A total of 127 members were tested in 2021 and 37 or 29% passed both the written and performance exam.

The 18 Ironworkers that successfully completed the Certified Rigger and Signalperson exams in 2021 at the Regional Training Centers went on to complete

the Proctor and Observer Training. They can now proctor written and performance exams at their home training centers.

Note: Each testing center must confirm they have a secure location and equipment for the computer-based exam, a secure location for the performance exam and the required rigging equipment kit, test load and frame. During all testing there must be an approved Proctor and Observer present.
