

IRONWORKER INSTRUCTOR PROGRAM – DRIVING & BUS DIRECTIONS TO PROGRAM SITES

Driving to the Ann Arbor Marriott Ypsilanti at Eagle Crest (approximately 16 miles from Detroit Airport)
1275 South Huron Street, Ypsilanti, MI 48197 (734-487-2000)

- Take I-94 to Exit 183 (Huron Street)
- Turn left from I-94 West or right from I-94 East and the hotel is the first left.

Driving to Eastern Michigan University (EMU)

- Take I-94 to Exit 183 (Huron Street)
- Turn right from I-94 West or left from I-94 East on South Huron Street.
- South Huron Street becomes North Huron Street which becomes North Huron River Drive
- Turn left onto Oakwood and then take the first right on the street between the parking lots (B and C).
- The Village Commons building is where Ironworker registration is located and is across from the C parking lot. You will also check in here to get your room key. If you arrive after hours, signs with instructions will be on the doors of the Village Commons building (you will need your cell phone).

Bus Transportation to EMU: Busses will run from the airport to EMU from 7:00 AM – 9:00 PM on 17 July and from 7:00 AM to 3:00 PM on July 18. Follow the signs to “Ground Transportation” (in either of the two terminals) and look for the “Metro Cars” desk. The person at the desk will direct you to the bus pick up point. Busses will run about every 30 minutes.

Once you have checked into the Marriott Hotel or the dorms EMU, those with cars will need to visit Ironworker registration at EMU to get an EMU parking pass (no pass required at Washtenaw Community College or WCC). Those staying at EMU without cars will be using the busses provided to get to and from WCC each day. Bus information will be available at check in. Refer to the campus maps on the reverse side of this information sheet as you follow these directions:

Directions from the Marriott to EMU (approximately 3 miles):

- Turn right at the entrance to the hotel on to South Huron Street and cross the bridge.
- South Huron Street becomes North Huron Street which becomes North Huron River Drive to EMU.
- To enter EMU, turn left on to Oakwood and then take the first right on the street between the parking lots (B and C).
- The Village Commons building is where Ironworker registration is located and is across from the C parking lot.

Directions from the Marriott to WCC (approximately 4.5 miles):

- Turn right at the entrance to the hotel on to South Huron Street and cross the bridge.
- South Huron Street becomes North Huron Street which becomes North Huron River Drive (note that at some point the road becomes Clark Road).
- Turn right on East Huron River Drive
- The second left will take you into the large parking lots.
- Refer to your course schedule for the building name and room number and use the map to locate your building.

Directions from EMU to WCC (approximately 1.5 miles):

- Exit the campus and turn left on North Huron River Drive (note that between EMU and WCC at some point the road becomes Clark Road).
- Turn right on East Huron River Drive
- The second left will take you into the large parking lots.
- Refer to your course schedule for the building name and room number and use the map to locate your building.

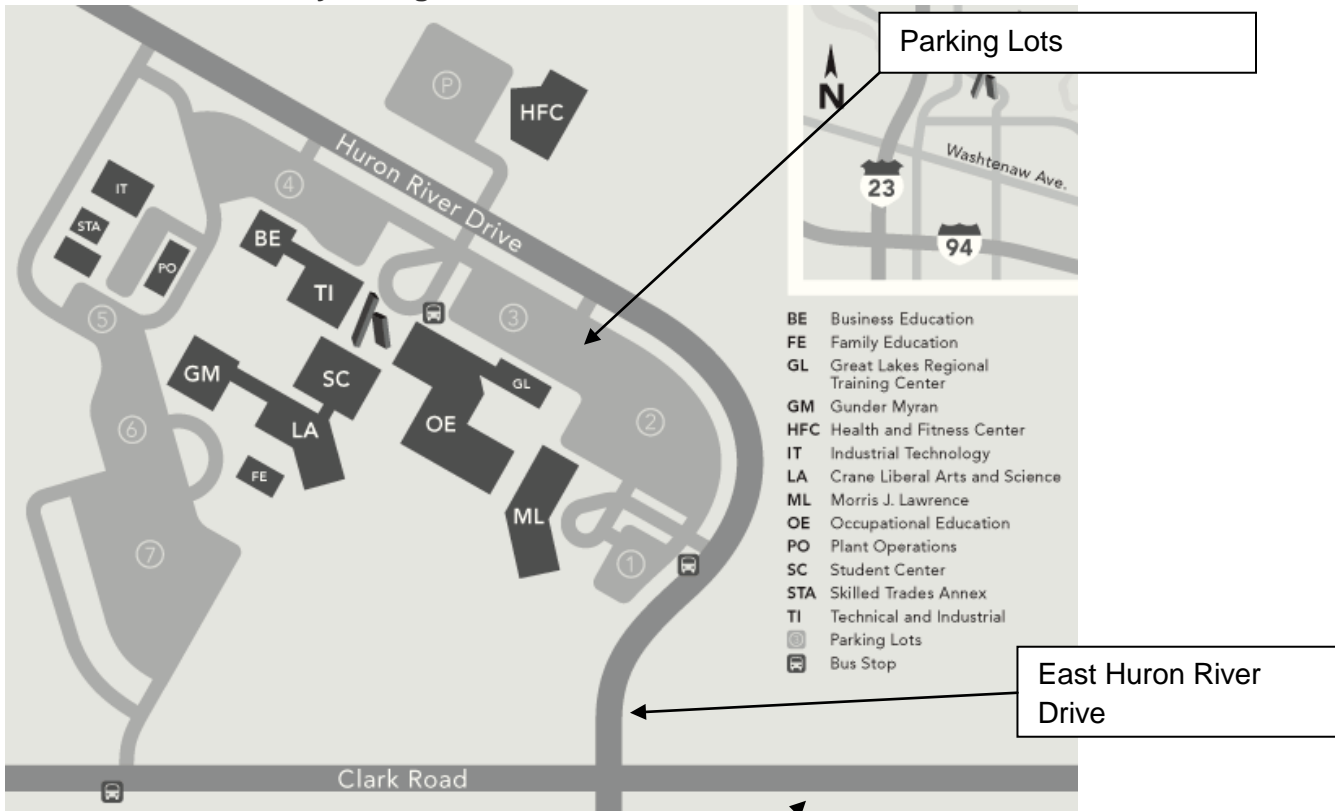
Directions from WCC to EMU and then back to the Marriott:

- Exit the parking lot and turn right onto East Huron River Drive.
- Turn left on Clark Road that becomes North Huron River Road.
- Turn right into EMU campus at Oakwood. Those staying at EMU will then park in the assigned lot(s).
- Those going on to the Marriott continue on Oakwood through campus.
- Turn left on Washtenaw Avenue (also marked as M-17) and stay in the right lane.
- Angle right to continue to follow M-17.
- Stay in the right lane and turn right on South Hamilton Street (US-12).
- As you approach I-94 stay in the left lane on South Huron Street and (after crossing the bridge) you will arrive at the Marriott Hotel on the left.
